Hello pilots

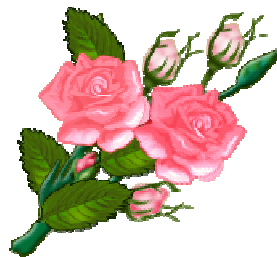
Can you believe January is almost gone? February will be a busy month for some of us. District Convention is coming up in April 9-11 in Atlanta.

PIF information regarding the RUBY NEWHALL MEMORIALSCHOLARSHIP:

As many members know, Ruby Newhall served as President of Pilot International, and her contacts with international students at the University of Florida strengthened her belief that these students could contribute significantly to improving international relations. After her death in 1949 her family suggested scholarship contributions in her memory in lieu of flowers. Established in 1949 the fund became a part of Pilot International Foundation in 1975. Eligible students from other countries could compete for this scholarship for specific studies in a field significant to the advancement of human health, education and welfare. In 1989 while serving as president of our club, we sponsored our first applicant to receive the scholarship. With the exception of three years since that time our club's nominee has received the scholarship and I congratulate you. 'TO DO GOOD IS TO FEEL GOOD--our club did just that!

In late fall as PIF representative of our club I began seeking a student to apply for the scholarship working with the Associate Director of International Education at GC&SU. When I called Jennifer Overbay at PIE Headquarters requesting an application, I learned that the scholarship will not be awarded this year. The plan is to reinstate the program next year under new guidelines. I was told that the funds had been spent down although there are still contributors
