July cool dessert

Triple Berry Cheesecake Tart

45 Nilla wafers, finely crushed (about 1-1/4 cups)
¼ cup (1/2 stick) butter, melted
1 pkg. (8oz) Philadelphia cream cheese, softened
¼ cup sugar
1 cup thawed cool whip whipped topping
2 cups mixed berries (raspberries, sliced strawberries and blueberries)
¾ cup boiling water
1 pkg. (3oz.) Jell-O Strawberry Flavor Gelatin
1 cup ice cubes

Make it

Step 1

Mix wafer crumbs and butter until well blended; press into bottom and up side of 9-inch tart pan. Freeze while preparing filling.

Step 2

Beat cream cheese and sugar in large bowl with mixer until well blended. Gently stir in COOL WHIP; spoon into crust. Top with berries, Refrigerate.

Step 3

Meanwhile, add boiling water to gelatin mix in medium bowl; stir 2 min. until completely dissolved. Add ice, stir until melted. Spoon over fruit in pan. Refrigerate 3 hrs or until set.
