Recipe of the Month

Fresh Apple Cake

- 3 cups flour
- 2 cups sugar
- 3 cups fresh apple sliced
- 3 eggs
- 1 cup oil
- 2 t vanilla
- 1 T cinnamon
- 1 t baking soda
- 1 t salt
- 2 cups chopped pecans

Mix all ingredients together and pour into a tub cake pan. I coated mine with cooking spray. Baked 1 hr at 350 degrees.

I baked mine 1 hr 10 min. as all ovens are different adjust accordingly.

This cake is so moist and delicious eaten warm or cold
