Many of you have great pear trees in your yards. I have a  
wonderful recipe that can be used for putting up in jars.

### Pear Honey

8 cups of pears that have been peeled and chopped in a  
blender.

4 cups of sugar

1 large can crushed pineapple

Put drained pears in a large pot, add sugar and crushed  
pineapple. Cook until done.

Prepare jars, fill with pear mixture. Boil in a water bath  
canner about 10 minutes. Remove and let cool.

This is really good on anything you would use pear  
preserves.
